

Swiss Medtech Dental Section Membership Fee Guidelines

These guidelines detail all aspects concerning membership fees of the Swiss Medtech Dental Section. All other aspects of membership and of the section are detailed in the Swiss Medtech Dental Section Rules of Procedure.

Membership Fees

Membership Fees for the Swiss Medtech Dental Section are due annually. The fees are tiered based on the number of employees* of the member company.

Number of Employees*	Annual Contribution (CHF)
1-5	1,000
6-10	1,000
11-25	1,500
26-50	1,500
51-100	2,000
101-250	3,000
251-500	4,000
501-1000	5,000
More than 1000	7,500

Payment Terms

Membership fees will be invoiced by the Swiss Medtech head office to each section member individually and separately. Membership fees are due annually upon receipt of invoice and must be paid within 30 days.

Late Payment

If the payment period is not adhered to, members will be considered in default without any dunning notice. In such cases, members will owe Swiss Medtech interest on arrears at a rate of 5% per annum on the outstanding fee.

Adjustments to Membership Fees

Membership fees are approved annually at the Dental Section General Assembly. Suggestions for reviews and adjustments may be made by the Board of the Swiss Medtech Dental Section in response to changes in the Section's budgetary needs or other relevant factors and put to vote at the General Assembly.

Non-payment

Failure to pay the contribution within the specified time frame may result in suspension or revocation of membership, at the discretion of the Board.
